Second School Resource Officer Hired by Pewaukee School District

Officer Kerry Corrus joins Current SRO, Julie Buddenhagen, as the Second Full-Time Security Presence On Campus

Pewaukee, **WI** - The Pewaukee School District, in collaboration with the Village of Pewaukee Police Department, has selected Officer Kerry Corrus as the second School Resource Officer (SRO) alongside Officer Julie Buddenhagen. Officer Corrus will partner with Officer Buddenhagen to manage all resource officer duties in service of students, families, staff and community. The new agreement with the Village of Pewaukee also extends the schedule of both officers to provide full coverage through the summer school session. She will begin duty on campus with the resumption of classes on January 2nd, 2023.

Officer Corrus has been a member of the Village of Pewaukee Police Department for the past 7 years, which has included specialized training and experience as a School Liaison Officer at Waukesha County Technical College. She is the recipient of the Community Service Commendium Award for training the Pewaukee School staff on trauma/medical care in the event of an active shooter.

"Having a second officer substantially increases capacity and improves flexibility for the District," shares Dr. Mike Cady, Superintendent of Schools. "This includes the ability to ensure we have coverage from the early arrival of students at the middle and high schools through the later afternoon dismissal of all elementary students.
