Dear PSD Families,

Like you, we are shocked and deeply saddened by the news of the shooting at Robb Elementary School in Texas on Tuesday. We share in the heartbreak we are all feeling for the families who have lost a loved one due to this senseless act of violence.

School should and must be a place where students feel completely safe and secure. As an added precaution and for peace of mind, we will have an increased police presence in and around our buildings for the rest of the week in addition to the daily presence of our School Resource Officer. As a school district we employ ongoing, universal precautions to maximize security and prepare for a crisis. One of the most important aspects of safety and security for our schools and community is the “see (or hear) something, say something” collective responsibility we share for protecting one another. Parents and students, we ask you to contact the administration, Officer Buddenhagen (262-695-5060), or the Village of Pewaukee Police Department if you become aware of any safety concerns.
